Presenters:

The Rev. Robert Denton, Ph.D., L.I.S.W. is the Executive Director of the Victim Assistance Program and an Adjunct Professor of Sociology at The University of Akron. Dr. Denton earned his B.A. Degree in Philosophy & Religion from Asbury College; M.A. in Theology from Wheaton Graduate School of Theology; Ph.D. in Social Welfare from the School of Applied Social Sciences, at Case Western Reserve University.

Dr. Denton has been team leader of national crisis responses to the **Oklahoma City Bombing, Hurricane Andrew, the Arkansas' tornados, the Lucasville riot, the Gainesville murders, the Radcliff, Kentucky bus crash, the Palm Bay Fla. massacre, National Liaison at Columbine High School, and New York City in the wake of the World Trade Center attack.** He has also served on the crisis teams which intervened at **Old Miss (Chi Omega deaths), Milwaukee (Dahmer killings), Mount Pleasant Iowa (killing of mayor and wounding of city council members) and Levittown GM Plant (loss of engineering staff in airline crash).**

The prevalence of bullying has become a daunting phenomenon in our society. Young or old, there are people who are consistently aggressive towards other. This seminar will examine policy and ethical issues of bullying in our culture.
